We follow William Ward for example from his birth place in Colchester through to the plains of India, the Crimean Peninsula and finally via Ireland to his death in Canada as a member of the 16th Regiment of Foot. We also meet his son, William James; who finds himself in a school for orphans at the age of seven and becomes an Army schoolmaster, ending his days as a Warrant Officer Class One with the 2nd Battalion of the Coldstream Guards at Wellington Barracks in London.
