.construction of this part of the building is evidently of different eras. The front of the church, erected in the reign of Edward II., is divided into three grand parts by massive graduated buttresses, enriched with tabernacle-work on every face. The elevated gable concealing the roof of the church, is covered with ornamental tracery of the most florid character, having the ridge beautifully terminated with a perforated battlement, the successive gradations of which are crested with a central pinnacle in exquisite taste. The three entrances upon this front are deemed not disproportioned to the grandeur of the elevation; the openings are deeply splayed with numerous shafts, whence flowered mouldings, with leaves in the grooves, spring from enriched capitals<sup>17</sup>. The central porch, opening to the nave, like many other western entrances of churches, is subdivided into two openings by a clustered pillar, but in the space, beneath...
