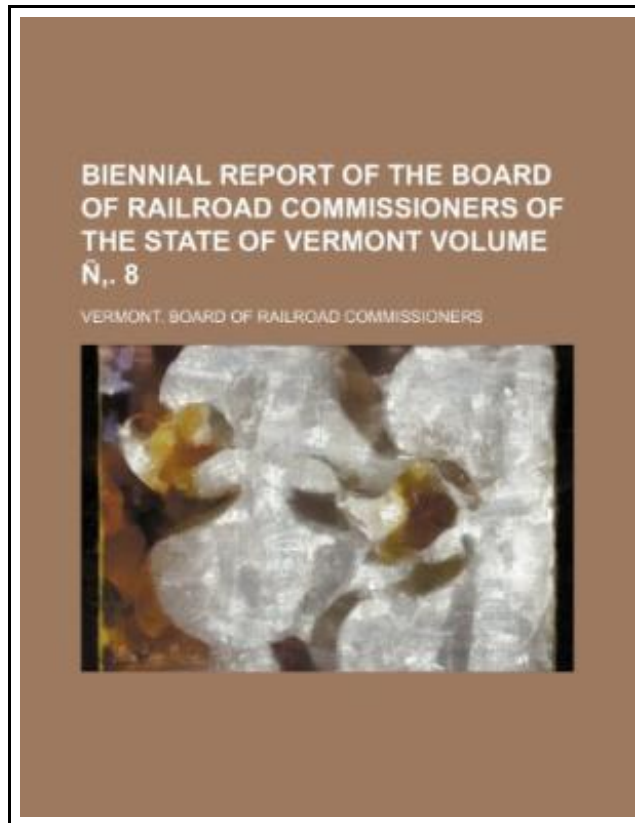

Not illustrated. 1902 Excerpt: . . . grade crossing about one-fourth mile south of the station at White River Junction. Ruth Jordan, a child of the age of eight years, was struck and killed by a passenger train on the Central Vermont Railway. The train was running at about twenty-five miles an hour, the brake having been applied and the speed reduced on entering the yard. When the engineer first saw the child she was standing near the east rail and was not looking in the direction from which the train was approaching. He sounded a danger signal and the brake being on at the time he applied it with more force and opened the sand blower. The child turned so as to face the train and in so doing moved a step or two nearer the rail. Her action was observed by a switchman who shouted to warn her. She made no movement and was struck by the fender-beam of the engine. Her position at the time was such that two steps would have taken her out of danger. The crossing whistle for this crossing was duly sounded and the bell was ringing at the time of the accident. The only question is whether the train could have been brought to a stop after the danger was discovered. The train consisted of only two cars both of which were equipped with air brakes in working order. The engineer testified that by reason of a curve in the track he did not see...
